THE MUST-HAVES for a Picture-Perfect Look

- Stick to Earthy, Neutral Tones
 Colors like creams, browns, deep
 greens, burgundy, and soft grays are
 your best friends for holiday sessions!
 These shades not only photograph
 beautifully but also keep things timeless
 and elegant.
- You don't need everyone in identical outfits! The goal is harmony—think similar styles or complementary colors that work well together. A mix of textures and fabrics (like knits, plaid, or soft lace) will add depth to your photos.
- 3 Scarves, hats, or cute headbands? Yes, please! These little details can bring the whole look together. But remember, accessories should enhance, not steal the show. Keep them subtle but stylish.





What to Avoid: Keep It Simple and Chic!



- Bright, Bold Colors

 As much as we all love a pop of color, bright reds, neon greens, or loud patterns can clash with the soft, cozy vibe we're going for. Stick to earthy tones for a natural, warm feel!
- No Logos or Graphics, Please
 Big logos or graphic tees can take away from the timeless look we want. Let's keep it classic and avoid distracting designs or slogans.
- Say No to Mismatched Socks & Shoes
 One small detail that can throw off the whole look:
 mismatched socks or shoes that don't go with the outfit!
 Make sure everyone's footwear is clean and complements the overall vibe.

Hair Prep.

Ladies and girls—soft curls or waves will look absolutely dreamy! Guys and boys—get that fresh haircut to keep things neat and polished.

- Dresses in velvet, satin, or tulle for a magical vibe. Long skirts, cozy knit sweaters, or elegant blouses. Think cozy + elegant, like you're dressing for Christmas Eve dinner. Sweaters layered over collared shirts look super cozy and timeless. Add a touch of sparkle or texture so the photos feel festive without being overthe-top.
- Boots & Accessories: bows, headbands, or delicate jewelry keep it festive but not distracting.
